If you don't currently have online access to your accounts, please ask your Investment Professional to help you sign up today. Once you've completed the online enrollment process, you can begin setting up your payees immediately and begin paying bills online.

To assist you in completing the online enrollment, you will need your bill pay/direct deposit account number and routing number. If you have an Investment Access® Account, both of these numbers are on the bottom of your checks or can be provided by your Investment Professional.
